Profiles: Search for the delegates based on affiliation, country or areas of interest. Profiles feature name, company and country as provided at registration. Please take a moment to edit your profile with your picture, job title and email address so your colleagues can find you via the delegates search.

Agenda: View/download the programme at a click of the button.

Lobby: Through virtual lobby access auditorium, exhibit hall, the poster hall, the networking lounge, or the information desk. Just select the room you want to enter

Exhibit Hall: Virtually visit 5 exhibitors in their unique designed booths. Learn about the latest tools, tips and trends in the Exhibit Hall. Chat with booth representatives, and explore the many documents, videos and resources they provide. Create your own conference swag bag - Add the interested documents, videos and resources to swag bag.

Video Vault: The exhibitors' videos are available all in one place in the vault. Add the ones you are interested in your swag bag. You can also select/filter as per the exhibitor.

Resources: The exhibitors documents, datasheet, factsheets etc are available under resources tab. Add the ones you are interested in your swag bag. You can also select/filter as per the exhibitor.

Swag Bag: Collect the videos, resources, documents from exhibitors in swag bag and email it to yourself.

Auditorium: Enter the auditorium to join us for plenary keynote sessions, focus sessions and soap box sessions including Q&A sessions post each talk. All presentations (pre-recorded presentations with audio) will be available for online viewing on demand. Each live Q&A session provides options to interact with the presenter. Selected times for live interactions will apply, but questions and answers will be recorded and remain accessible one month after the conference. Watch it on demand at a later stage. **Please post comments to presenters in a chat box tied to their presentation and questions in a chat box tied to live Q&A sessions.**

Information desk: first place for any queries, Pick up your registration pack here, video tutorial to guide you through the platform, list of delegates.

e-poster: 56 posters are organised in the Poster Hall. click on pdf to view the posters. Presenters have in many cases have submitted a short video highlighting the key points in a theme. Click watch presentation to view the video presentation. You can also ask questions to presenters in a chat box tied to their presentation.

Networking lounge: The platform offers great networking possibilities, so you can arrange to meet up with colleagues and talk with them just as if you were at an ordinary conference. Engage with others in the lounge. Choose from one-to-one interaction or pick one of the chat room based on discussion forum (check timings). You can also visit Exhibitions, Poster hall, delegates profiles and linked-in from lounge. Search for your peers based on affiliation, country or areas of interest.

Connect with an individual delegate: See who is online in the networking lounge and connect with peers directly by chat or search for delegates based on their profile information.

Connect with the presenter of a poster or talk: Go to the Q&A linked to the presentation and leave a note for the presenter. Presenters review and answer to the comments

Connect to delegates in discussion forum: The EuPFI has newly introduced discussion forum to connect with colleagues on selected topics. It is available through networking lounge and you can connect with delegates, either individually or as a group. **Do not forget to update your profile to indicate your interest in one or more of these topics.**

Note, that all attendees can chat directly with others who are online in the chat rooms.

1 Technology

2 Profile Information and Connecting With Other Delegates

Please take a moment to edit your profile and indicate areas of interest so your colleagues can find you via the delegates search. Note, that all attendees can chat directly with others who are online in the delegates lounge and in the topical chat rooms, so you may want to join some specific chats based on your interests.

You can use your computer's search function (Cntrl F for PC or command F for Mac) to search for a specific online user in the chatrooms. Once you find an online user in the lounge, click the "chat" button to start a private conversation.

You can disable notifications (pings from chat) from the menu near your profile in the top right hand. Chats are not quite threaded but to reply to a specific comment in chats, hover over it till the reply button appears to answer it.

3 Programme Tips

Pre-recorded and Live Sessions

- If you plan to attend a live session discussion, you are encouraged to view presentations (talks and posters) for that session ahead of time. The 10-minute Q&A sessions are more productive when you have reviewed the presentations. The presentations will not be reviewed in-depth in the live discussions.
- Join the session at the stated time. They are timed and will start on time and you will miss the section of the talk for you join late. However, presentations are available on-demand soon after the session has taken place, so you can catch up on what you might have missed.

On-Demand Presentations

- The chat boxes associated with presentations are live 24 hours during the meeting. Be sure to visit often to see inquiries and responses.
