About the conference

Building on the success of previous meetings, EuPFI 2020 will feature a wide range of sessions and learning opportunities, showcasing the current state of play and rapidly evolving innovations with the potential to make a long-term transformational change.

European Paediatric Formulation initiative (EuPFI) is a consortium of members working in a pre-competitive way on paediatric drug formulations.
